Chapter 1

Everywhere Add-on Overview & Installation

1.1 Overview

The Everywhere add-on for JReviews extends the user review system functionality of JReviews to other Joomla components such as: business directories, galleries, e-commerce stores, file repositories, social networking and more.

Integration is convenient and incredibly powerful!

Manage all of your site's reviews and ratings with one system and a uniform, themeable look. You don't lose flexibility because the configuration for each component can be different:

1. **Multiple sets of rating criteria:** each category in your component can have a different rating criteria set. For example, in a business directory, suppliers of services could have different rating criteria than suppliers of goods.
2. **Custom fields in reviews:** you can use JReviews' custom fields system for reviews to expand the review form by asking additional questions such as: date of purchase, pros/cons, experience with product, would you recommend?, etc. All the custom field types used for jReviews can also be used for jReviewsEverywhere in reviews.
3. **Comprehensive MyReviews page:** Reviews submitted in all components are shown together in a user's MyReviews page and they link back to the appropriate component detail page.
4. **Moderate reviews in one place:** All component reviews are moderated in the JReviews administration.

Important: The Everywhere add-on does not integrate with 3rd party component rating systems, it remains a separate rating system. For example, a top rated list for your 3rd party component will not use user ratings from Everywhere add-on. Also, the Everywhere add-on doesn't enable searching for user reviews in 3rd party components.




2.3 Displaying the review form and reviews in EasySocial profiles

To display the review form in EasySocial profiles, it is necessary to install the **Review Me** app for EasySocial which can be found in the JReviews package that you downloaded from the Client Area. The file that you need to install is this:

```
/package_jreviews_2.4.x_unzip_first/plugins_everywhere_addon/easysocial/reviewme.zip
```

To install it, go to the EasySocial Application Installer:

3.3 Displaying the review form and reviews in JomSocial profiles


To display the review form in JomSocial profiles, it is necessary to install the **Reviews of Me** plugin for JomSocial which can be found in the JReviews package that you downloaded from the Client Area. The file that you need to install is this:

To install it, go to the Joomla Extension Manager:

4.2 Assigning the JReviews listing type to Community Builder categories

Next step is to go to the Everywhere add-on:



Click the **Select Extension** dropdown, choose **Community Builder** and click the **Setup New** button:



There are two different ways to setup the Everywhere integration with Community Builder:

4.2.1 Using access groups as categories

This approach would allow you to assign a listing type to specific user groups. If you want to enable reviews for registered users, but not for other types of user, this is the best approach.

After you click the **Setup New** button, in the popup form select the listing type that you created and choose user groups for which you want to enable reviews:

4.2.2 Using CB custom field options as categories

If you need to differentiate users of a specific user group and enable reviews only for specific users based on their field values, it is possible to use CB field options as categories. You would even be able to assign different listing type with different rating criteria and fields to different users. This would be useful for example in:

- Student/Teacher site
- Freelancer site: professionals/employers
- Community site where businesses sign up to the site to offer their services. Businesses in different industries can have different rating criteria

The first step for this approach is to create a new CB field. Go to the Community Builder component and click the **Field Management**. Click the **New Field** button, enter the values and click the **Save** button:

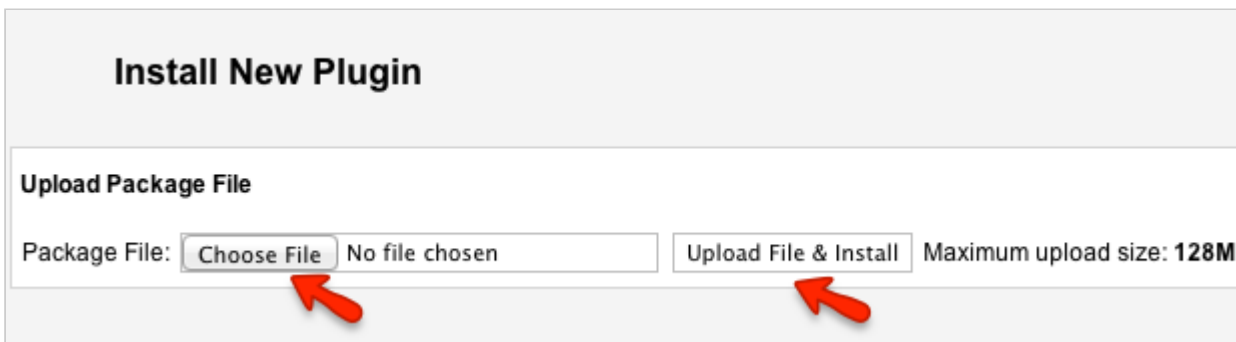

4.3 Displaying the review form and reviews in Community Builder profiles

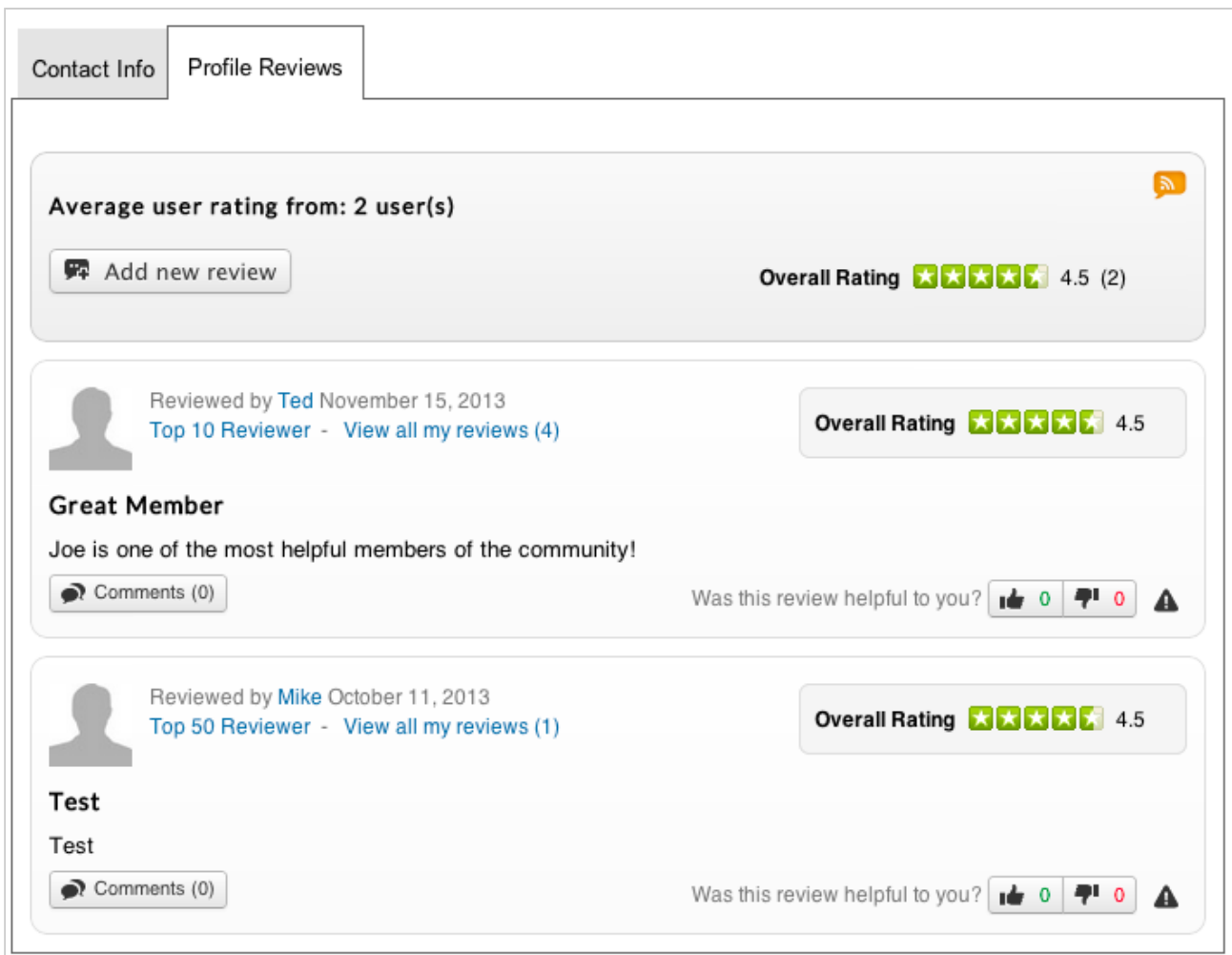
To display the review form in Community Builder profiles, it is necessary to install the **CB JReviews Everywhere** plugin for Community Builder which can be found in the JReviews package that you downloaded from the Client Area. The file that you need to install is this:

```
/package_jreviews_2.4.x_unzip_first/plugins_everywhere_addon/community_builder/plug_cbjreviews_everywhere.zip
```

To install it, go to the Community Builder component, click the **Plugin Management** and at the bottom of the page you will find the plugin installer:



Publish the **CB JReviews Everywhere** plugin on the **Plugin Management** page and then go to the **Tab Management** page and make sure that the **Profile Reviews** tab is published as well. Then the **Profile Reviews** will show up in all profiles for which you enabled the integration:



Chapter 5

Theme Customizations

The Everywhere add-on uses this theme file:

```
/components/com_jreviews/jreviews/views/themes/default/everywhere/reviews.html
```

If you want to customize it, first copy it to your custom theme in `jreviews_overrides` as shown in [JReviews Code Overrides \(http://docs.reviewsforjoomla.com/?title=JReviews_Code_Overrides\)](http://docs.reviewsforjoomla.com/?title=JReviews_Code_Overrides) :

```
/templates/jreviews_overrides/views/themes/{your_theme}/everywhere/reviews.html
```

Individual reviews in Everywhere add-on use the same theme file as reviews of JReviews listings:

```
/components/com_jreviews/jreviews/views/themes/default/reviews/review_layout.html
```

Copy it to the custom theme before customizing:

```
